

## SAILING INSTRUCTIONS – ATTACHMENT 1

These Sailing Instructions refer specifically to *slalom racing*.

### 1. RULES

The racing will be governed by the rules as defined in the Racing Rules of Sailing – Windsurfing Competition Rules, as changed by Appendix B.10.

### 2. CHANGES TO SAILING INSTRUCTIONS

If oral instructions or changes to the sailing instructions will be given flag "L" shall be shown at least 5 minutes before the instructions or changes. Sufficient effort has to be made to inform all the competitors involved.

### 3. SIGNALS MADE ASHORE

When **Flag S** is displayed slalom racing is the chosen format for the next race.

### 4. THE START

4.1 Races will be started using the following signals:

<i>Minutes before start signal</i>	<i>Visual signal</i>	<i>Sound signal</i>	<i>Means</i>
Not less than 3	Heat number	None	
3	Class flag	One	Attention signal
2	Red flag; Class flag removed	One	Warning signal
1	Yellow flag; Red flag removed	One	Preparatory signal
½	Yellow flag removed	One	Half minute
0	Green flag	One	Starting start

This modifies WCR 26

4.2 A board starting later than 2 minutes after her starting signal will be scored Did Not Start. **This changes WCR A4 and A5.**

### 5. TIME LIMITS

A board failing to finish within 3 minutes of the first board in her heat will be scored Did Not Finish (DNF) without a hearing. **This changes WCRs 35, A4 and A5.**

### 6. PROTESTS & REQUESTS FOR REDRESS

B 10 63 and 70 apply.

### 7. SCORING

B 10 – A2 is deleted.

### 8. SEEDING

Heats for the first round will be based on the ranking available at 2100 on the day before the slalom racing is scheduled.
